IMPORTANT NOTICE - New data protection laws come into force next month preventing all organisations, including churches, from storing or using an individual's personal details (eg. name, phone number, e-mail address etc), unless that individual has given their express consent. **After next month, we will not be able to ring you up or email you or write to you, nor keep your personal details on any church list, without your express permission.** A consent form will be sent out to every church member over the next few weeks, so please would you complete it and return it to the office as soon as possible. You can choose what specific items you are giving consent to, and you can amend or withdraw your consent at any time. Many apologies if this all seems a bit over the top, but the PCC's have to ensure they comply with the new legislation, otherwise they risk having to pay a huge fine.
