Fruitfulness on the Frontline2: Starting on **Thursday, 12th Oct** – Fruitfulness on the Frontline2 course begins. The course will run in church every Thursday for 5 weeks, between 10.30 am and 12.15, repeated at 7.30 - 9.15 pm, to enable as many people as possible to attend. It explores how we as a church might be (more) fruitful for God here in Nailsea, with all its schools and houses and offices and its growing number of retirement homes. In this connection the course also introduces the proposed Vision for Christ Church over the coming years, and the new initiatives being considered with regard both to our mission work in the parish and to our actual church building in order that we might better minister to this changing population.
