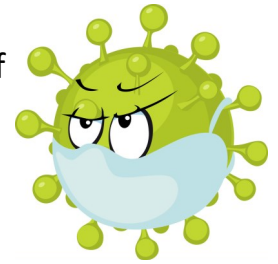


Covid Regulations Revisited

Taking into account the government move to step 4 of the roadmap out of lockdown, together with case numbers in North Somerset which are currently increasing, we decided on the guidance below in order that we can continue to worship together safely.



Church

- Please continue to use the hand gel provided when entering church.
- The church will be split into two zones, one for those who wish to continue full social distancing wearing masks and one for those who wish to be more relaxed.
- We are strongly encouraging people to continue to wear facemasks, this is mandatory if you wish to join us in singing
- Please continue to use the track and trace QR code
- Taking communion in both kinds will commence immediately by simultaneous administration. Clergy will continue to wear a visor during communion administration.

Groups

Church groups that recommence should conduct their own risk assessment keeping note of attendees. (Risk assessment forms available from the office— please call Annabel for help and further information.)

The above rules are aimed at keeping us all safe. If you are clinically extremely vulnerable (CEV) or very vulnerable, please feel free to talk to our wardens should you have concerns with the above.

Under current Church of England guidelines, it is not appropriate to ask if people have been vaccinated.
