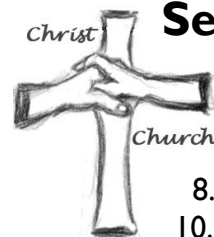

This information can be used by emergency services, health professionals or community members to get the wearer back to safety should they be found lost or confused. To apply for a wristband, visit the Dementia Safeguarding Scheme (also known as the Herbert Protocol).
