Connect Prayer Meeting we meet on Wednesday 8th September between 8 and 9 a.m. at Wetherspoons. Neil will update us on the new school year!

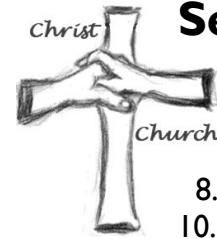
